I am planning to take Year 10 pupils to Queen Elizabeth Sixth Form College on **Wednesday 21st June 2023**. I would like to give pupils the opportunity to look around Queen Elizabeth Sixth Form College and experience its facilities firsthand, before they start making their college/sixth-form applications in November 2023. Visiting the campus in person will provide invaluable insight into the courses on offer and will enable our pupils to make an informed decision about where they would like to study when they leave Risedale, post-16.

Choosing Taster Sessions:

Arrangements for the day:

- **Transport:** Coaches will depart Risedale at 9am returning back to school at 12.20 pm.
- **Food:** Pupils will be back at school for lunchtime and so do not need to bring any additional food with them for the trip.
- **Clothing:** Pupils will be required to wear school uniform as they will be attending their afternoon lessons as normal.
