SUBJECT: Headteacher's Letter - October 2022

Reminders on Uniform

At Risedale we believe that our uniform helps pupils to feel part of the Risedale Family. The school uniform and PE kit are a requirement for every pupil and are available to purchase from <u>www.school-shop.co.uk</u>



I am really pleased that we have been able to keep our uniform costs to an absolute minimum by reducing the need for items to have logos on them. Please shop around for general items of uniform, such as white shirts, trousers or skirts (of a reasonable length). You'll find supermarkets and other shops will often have great value items.

Having listened to many of you late last year, and given the heatwave we all endured, I asked governors at their meeting this month to allow an amendment to the uniform policy to allow pupils to wear plain black trouser-type/tailored shorts as part of their uniform instead of trousers or skirts in hot summer months, which they have agreed to. Our policy on uniform will therefore be amended to show that change.

Attendance, Absence and Punctuality



Attendance and Absence: We all know that good attendance matters and that regular school attendance maximises your child's learning potential. Pupils who regularly attend school make better progress socially and academically. We want to be able to give your child every chance to be a successful adult and good attendance is key to this.

As a parent/carer, it is your responsibility to make sure your child is punctual and attends school every day. We monitor all pupils' attendance and punctuality closely every week.

If a pupil is unwell and cannot attend school we ask that a parent/carer call the school and leave a message before 9:00 am.

To do this you can either telephone the school on 01748 833501 and select option 1 to report an absence <u>OR</u> send an email to <u>absence@risedale.org.uk</u>. By phone or email, please include the following information:

- Your name (parent/carer first name and surname).
- Your child's name (pupil's first name and surname).
- Your child's tutor group.
- Nature of illness.
- Approximately how long you believe the illness may last.

Punctuality: Pupils are expected to arrive at school on time and be ready for Tutor Time at 8.30 am.

If a child arrives late they will be required to sign in at reception. Pupils arriving after 9.30 am without an acceptable reason will be marked as an unauthorised absence. 10 or more late marks could lead to a fixed penalty notice.

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Chromebooks



Every pupil is allocated a Chromebook when they join the Risedale Family. When treated with care and respect, a pupil's Chromebook should last for the duration of their time with us at Risedale (5yrs).

The majority of pupils are really appreciative of this fantastic resource and are showing great maturity in looking after them properly. Unfortunately, a minority of pupils are not looking after their Chromebooks as well as they should, and as such, it is beginning to increase the number of repairs we have to undertake.

Please remind your child that it is essential for them to carry their Chromebook safely in the case it was supplied in. The charger should never be stored in the case alongside the Chromebook because if the case is bumped or squashed the plug can damage the Chromebook. Ideally, all Chromebooks should be charged every night at home so the charger does not need to be brought into school.

Chromebooks must not be written on, have stickers stuck on them or have graffiti scratched into them. Any sort of personalisation is strictly forbidden and unnecessary as every Chromebook is logged and registered from our central database.

If any Chromebook is maliciously or intentionally damaged there will be an expectation for parents or carers to pay towards the cost of repair. Of course, this will be a rare occurrence and will not affect most of the Risedale Family.

Thank you in advance for your assistance in ensuring we are able to continue supplying this important resource to your child and to other pupils in the future.
