Our local / contextual safeguarding issues

- **Child Criminal Exploitation:** Children are encouraged, tricked or forced to take part in criminal activities (e.g. stealing, selling or holding drugs).
- **Child-on-Child Abuse:** A behaviour by an individual or group, intending to physically, sexually or emotionally harm others.
- **Derogatory Language:** Words or phrases used to express a low opinion, a lack of respect, or criticism, often with the intent to hurt, demean, or insult someone or something.
- **Online Safety:** Children putting themselves at risk online or being at risk of harm from other internet users or content.
- **Vaping:** Health risks, exploitation.

MAST

The **Multi-Agency Screening Team** are responsible for looking at referrals and deciding the next steps to take. The DSL or DDSL send referrals to MAST for them to review.

LADO

The **Local Area Designated Officer** is responsible for managing allegations against adults who work with children.

The DSL or Chair of Governors would work with the North Yorkshire LADO to manage any allegation made against members of staff or volunteers working in school.
