Dear parent/carer,

IMPORTANT: Year 11 Compulsory Intervention and Revision Sessions

Now that we have completed the Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs), teachers have a more focused plan for revision sessions. These have been held over the last half term but will increase over the coming weeks.

As you are aware from the correspondence before the half-term break, we have a number of intervention and revision sessions, both in registration, at lunchtime and after school. These are designed to aid learning in the classroom and help increase grades in all subjects. The revision sessions will count towards the pupils' 'Prom Passport,' which gives the opportunity to go to the Prom.

Intervention sessions will be targeted at specific individual pupils and are compulsory, whereas the attendance of all Year 11 pupils at general revision sessions is encouraged. Pupils must be actively attending revision (and intervention, where requested) sessions to allow them access to the Prom.

We would be grateful if you could support by talking to your child about the importance of the next few months, and making every minute count.
