SUBJECT: Year 11 GCSE Exams & Attendance Update

We are extremely proud of the resilience, determination and respect that our Year 11 pupils are demonstrating around school. We are now approaching the final few weeks of examinations and we are looking to ensure these are as focused and productive as possible for all of our pupils.

With examinations in many subjects having now ended, we will be looking to make adaptations to the curriculum for our Year 11 pupils so that the lessons they are in are as relevant and meaningful as possible. Please read the following information about the end of Year 11 arrangements very carefully and keep it to hand for your reference, as it contains important details about the coming weeks.

From Tuesday 11th June, we will be providing focused revision sessions in specific subjects for our pupils, which we expect them to attend. The timetable on Page 2 details when these revision sessions are taking place.

If a pupil is not attending any particular revision session, due to not studying that subject, there are then two options:

- **Option 1:** Should you wish for your child to stay in school, we will provide staffed revision rooms, where pupils can quietly revise.
- **Option 2:** Alternatively, **after the Science examination on Tuesday 11th June**, we will allow pupils to leave school and study from home **when they do not have an examination**.

Parental Consent: If you would like your child to work from home from 11th June then, for safeguarding reasons, please provide your consent via the form that will be sent to your email address via EVOLVE by **Monday 10th June**. Failure to consent will mean that your child will have to remain in school every day until their final examination. **It is critical your child is still on time for any examinations during this period.**

Year 11 Leavers' Assembly: All Year 11 Risedale pupils are invited to a special Leavers' Assembly taking place at 2.30pm on Wednesday 19th June 2024. Refreshments will be provided.
