

#### **Pillars of Success**











The five pillars: The main mantra of our curriculum is to be inclusive, to challenge and engage all pupils positively in their learning through a broader understanding of the world around them. Throughout this, we emphasise kindness and empathy through a family ethos. To achieve this, we have 5 clear pillars which underpin our whole school curriculum vision.

- Teaching and learning at Risedale is a two way process where pupils and teachers communicate together to ensure that all pupils can make progress.
- Every teacher at Risedale wants your child to succeed. As such, high quality lessons are designed using an adaptive teaching model so that all learners' needs are responded to within the cycle of learning.
- Our staff are experts in their subject field and regularly undergo training to keep updated with the most recent pedagogical approaches which they then apply to their lessons.
- Pupils at Risedale are challenged to think hard in all of their lessons and are encouraged to be inquisitive about their learning.
- We encourage our learners to have a voice and there are regular opportunities
  to share their views on teaching and learning through a range of pupil voice
  and book talks as part of our school monitoring cycle.



How will I know how my child is getting on academically at Risedale?

- Three times a year you will receive a report about your child's progress.
- This report currently includes:
  - Attendance
  - Minimum Expected Grade (MEG) an end of year target grade based on KS2 SATs
  - How your child is currently performing compared to their end of year MEG
  - What Excellent Learning Looks Like (WELLL) – your child's attitude to learning




