SUBJECT: Y9 Enrichment Trip to Saltburn (17th July 2024)

At Risedale we believe that school trips and enrichment opportunities are so important to pupils' development. I am pleased to let you know that we are able to offer a whole-year-group excursion to Saltburn on Wednesday 17th July for which there will be **no cost** to parents/carers.

The aim of the trip is to provide pupils with the opportunity to visit a historic coastal town with an important literary and geographical heritage. Saltburn has been and continues to be, an inspiring location for visitors from near and far, providing an enjoyable day out for all those who are lucky enough to explore its stunning beaches, funicular cliff tramway and pier. Pupils will get an opportunity to spend some time on the beach, building sandcastles or taking part in beach games. They will also get a chance to spend time in the beautiful 'Valley Gardens', where they may get a chance to take a ride on the historic miniature railway (to be confirmed closer to the date).

Dates and Times

The excursion will take place on Wednesday 17th July 2024. Pupils will travel by coach, departing Risedale School at 8:45am and returning by 3pm.

Food and Spending Money

Pupils who normally receive Free School Meals will be provided with a packed lunch for the day. For all other pupils, food will **not** be provided and they will need to either bring a packed lunch or have money to buy food in Saltburn. There are plenty of places to buy fish and chips or ice cream along the seafront. It may also be possible to spend a small amount of money in the traditional seaside arcades.

Clothing and Behaviour

Pupils are to wear their own clothes for the day and we would remind parents that although it will be July, please be conscious that weather can be variable. Please make sure pupils have adequate and appropriate clothing and sun/rain protection.

Although pupils will not be in uniform, they are still representing the school and any poor behaviour will be appropriately sanctioned. Risedale staff members will be easily accessible to pupils at all times.

Please be aware this trip is a privilege and any poor behaviour prior to the excursion may result in pupils not being permitted to come. This is at the school's discretion.

A consent form will be sent via EVOLVE to your email address, and we kindly request that you complete it no later than **Friday 14th June** to secure your child's place.

Your child will be covered by the School/Educational Journey Insurance.
