Equipment List

One of the best ways to make sure pupils have a good start to the day is by being prepared and having all the equipment they need. Below is a list of items that all pupils are expected to bring with them each day and Form Tutors will check each morning.

- School bag
- A pencil case containing the following:
 - a black biro, red biro and blue biro,
 - pencil
 - ruler
 - eraser
- PE kit (on timetabled day for PE).
- Reading book (KS3 only).

Other items of stationery such as colouring pencils and glue sticks can be a useful addition to a pupil's pencil case, however, items such as pencil sharpeners, scissors and cutting knives are not permitted. PLEASE NOTE: This is a change to the current timings of our school day. From September 2025, we will have a two week timetable and 5 x 1 hour lessons each day. The start and finish times of the school day will remain the same – we have simply changed the distribution of the hours for maximum impact on learning.


