



Schoolwide Behaviour Consequences

RS3 Reflection Room

Build-up of Negatives:

- 12 negative points per week = isolation
- We will try and support any pupil who is close to 12 negative points before they get to this stage

Reflection Room Duration:

- 1st isolation: 6 complete lessons (1 full day)
- 2nd isolation: 12 complete lessons (2 full days)
- 3rd isolation: 18 complete lessons (3 full days)
- 4th isolation: Suspension

Failure to comply in Reflection Room:

- a) First instance in a day: A clear VERBAL warning
- b) Second instance in a day: SLT called and a WRITTEN warning
- c) Third instance in a day: SLT called, a conversation with a member of SLT. Where possible the member of SLT will have a conversation with parents/carers WITH the pupil present to inform them pupil is at risk of suspension. Pupil will have isolation extended by an EXTRA day
- d) Suspension (length dependent upon behaviours and previous suspensions)

STAGE 4: Suspension or Permanent Exclusion

- Unprovoked assault
- Refusal to hand in mobile phone
- Setting off the fire alarm
- Refusal to go to the Reflection Room
- Persistent poor behaviour in the Reflection Room
- Sustained abuse to staff or pupils

STAGE 3: Reflection Room

- Inciting a fight/physical incident (Pending investigation)
- Multiple negative incidents (Build-up of -12 points)
- Smoking/vaping
- Internal truancy
- Intentional damage/vandalism (Parents/carers will be charged)
- Refusal to go to Buddy Room
- Verbal abuse (Pending investigation)

STAGE 2: Comment on Bromcom / MCAS (-2 points)

- Bullying
- Defiance
- Damage to Chromebooks

STAGE 1: Comment on Bromcom / MCAS (-1 point)

- Lateness
- Lack of respect
- Litter
- Eating outside of the Canteen/DT Quad and/or being out of bounds
- Incorrect uniform
- Lack of equipment
- Chewing gum
