Uniform and Equipment Reminders

Please remember to equip your child with the following:

- A pencil case. We cannot lend equipment at the moment and it is an important skill to be organised for learning.
- A mask in case it is needed. Please note that during normal operations, and unless there is a local lockdown, pupils and staff are free to decide if they want to wear a mask in communal areas. They should not be used in the classroom as this may hinder communication and in accordance with government guidance.
- A coat as it is getting colder and is sometimes damp we do please ask that you provide a coat for your child. A lot of students are still arriving without coats.
- Hoodies are not allowed but plain, black jumpers under blazers are allowed.
- We have had some concerns regarding skirts and these have been addressed by Ms Benson and form tutors. However, if there continue to be issues with individual students they will be asked to wear trousers to school instead.
